Is the caregiver certified in			
First Aid and CPR?			
What are their qualifications,			
experiences, and education?			
Do the caregivers promote			
development of positive self-			
esteem?			
Are the children greeted when			
they arrive? Do			
caregivers/teachers get down			
on the child's level?			
Are there a variety of age			
appropriate activities?			
Is there a daily balance of story			
time, activity time, nap time			
and play time?			
Will my child get individual			
attention?			
Will my child be able to grow			
socially, emotionally, physically			
and intellectually?			
Can parents visit the program			
and participate in the			
activities?			
Do the caregivers share			
information about my child's			
day?			
Are references provided? Would I feel comfortable			
leaving my child here?			
Are the group size and age			
groupings acceptable? (ask			
school experts about the best			
staff/child ratios)			
Are surprise visits			
encouraged?			
What are the discipline			
methods? Do they promote			

self-discipline?						
What are the procedure for						
dropping off and picking up my						
child?						
Is there a procedure for						
releasing the children to						
someone other than myself?						
What is the procedure if my						
child becomes sick?						
Is there a license posted?						
For School-agers						
Is there an ample supply of						
age appropriate reading						
materials & educational games						
that the children have access						
to?						
Is there a time set aside for						
homework?						
Is there transportation to and						
from school?						
Is there an adult supervising						
the children at all times?						
Is this program available to the
